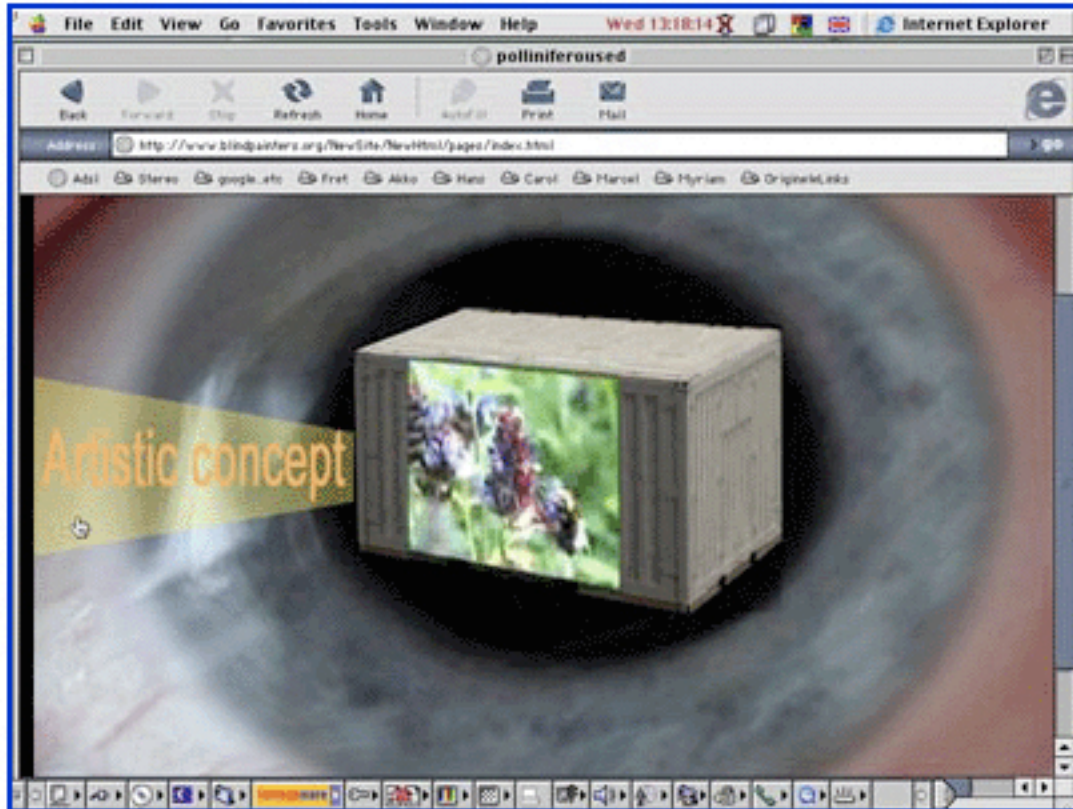

The Blindpainters Foundation, an Amsterdam based art organisation, is proud to present a new part in her extensive web site about the:

Polliniferoused Container Project

polliniferous [poliniferus] adj. producing or carrying of pollen.

It's a selfsufficient, high tech, living- and working unit, developed with the focus on sustainability and modelled on a standard sea container. The container acts as an artist laboratory that will visit twelve locations worldwide within a period of five years; literally from pole- till desert climate.

The concept is by Hans Kalliwoda, one of the founders of the Blindpainters, who also initiated and conducted the previous large-scale europartrain project. His work demands interaction, involvement and communication, and is always multi-disciplinary. Creating networks all around the world is an important aim.

The project is supported by the Rector Magnificus of the TU-Delft (University of Technology in Delft, Holland) and enables inter-faculty project education in a very special way. The artist's intervention in a technical surrounding creates a unique platform for students, profs and the artist; bringing the arts and technology together in an 'arTech' interactive communication zone.
